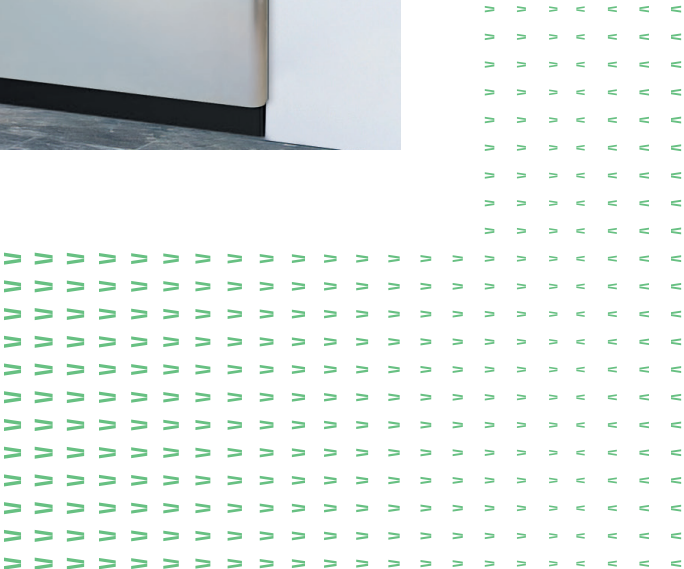


SCAN. SORT. DISPENSE.

Gantner Wristband Dispenser GWD7



For water parks, public swimming pools and leisure facilities, the GWD7 automates the sorting and dispensing of silicone wristbands. Guests scan their ticket; the system validates the request and dispenses the correct wristband in a matter of seconds.



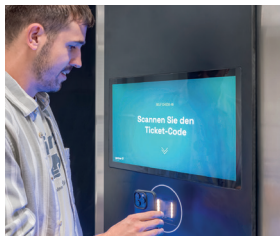
Key Benefits

- > Automatic sorting and dispensing machine for GAT Chip Band 20 wristbands.
- > Dispensing time of less than 2 seconds – fast check-in even during peak visitor times.
- > Capacity for more than 1,500 wristbands – enough for a whole day.
- > 24/7 self-service: Takes the pressure off reception and reduces queues.
- > Quick refilling without pre-sorting, directly from the Gantner Return (GRT7).
- > 21-inch touchscreen.
- > Integrated barcode scanner for printed or mobile tickets.
- > Customisable lighting in the dispensing area.
- > Compact footprint of approx. 85x70 cm.
- > Direct API connection to ticketing and management systems.



From ticket to wristband

01



Scan

The guest scans the QR code or barcode on their mobile or printed ticket.

02



Validate

The ticketing system checks the request via API and authorises the issue of the wristband in the selected size.

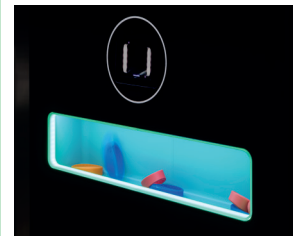
03



Sorting

The GWD7 sorts the wristbands internally and automatically selects the appropriate GAT Chip Band 20.

04



Dispensing

The illuminated dispensing area presents the authorised wristband for collection.
